SUBJECT: DETERMINATION OF CUSTOMS VALUE OF PLASTIC BABY FEEDERS UNDER SECTION 25A OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969

Valuation of Plastic Baby Feeders was determined vide Valuation Ruling dated 18-01-2010. Since the said ruling has been considerably old and needed updation as per current international prices, the same was taken up for fresh determination of values.

2. Accordingly, meetings were held on 14-09-2011 & 14-12-2011 to obtain the view point of the importers and other stakeholders. These were attended by importer's representatives, who were of the view that current market prices of raw material may also be considered while revising the customs values. In order to determine fair customs values, the import data was examined within the meaning of section 25(5) & (6) of the Customs Act, 1969, which transpired that the assessment of goods namely Plastic Baby Feeders, were more or less made on the basis of non-branded goods. It was noticed from the clearance data that brands of goods have not been declared and most of the subject goods were cleared on the values determined for the un-branded feeders, in the existing Valuation Ruling. Later on local market enquiry, under section 25(7) ibid, was conducted. According to market survey of Plastic Baby Feeders, the prices of branded goods were found in the range of US\$6.32 to US\$11.38/kg, while the price of unbranded goods were significantly lower. With regard to comparison of value in terms of the provisions of section 25(8) of the Customs Act, 1969, prices of raw material in the international market, as available in the periodical viz; 'Polymer aw material in the international market, as available in the periodical viz; 'Polymer as a state of the price of unbranded goods were section 25(8) of the Customs Act, 1969, prices of
