SUPPLY (UPS) UNDER SECTION 25-A OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969

(VALUATION RULING NO.677 / 2014

No. Misc/25/2013-VII

Dated: June 30, 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969 the Customs values of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) are determined as follows:-

- Background of the valuation issue: Customs values of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) were determined under Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969, vide Valuation Ruling No.447/2012 dated 26-03-2012. In order to reflect the current international market prices, an exercise to re-determine the Customs values of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) was initiated in terms of Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969.
- 2. Method adopted to determine Customs values: Valuation methods given in Section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969 were followed. Transaction value method provided in Sub-Section (1) of Section 25 was found inapplicable because the requisite information to determine the value as per law was not available. Identical / similar goods value methods provided in Sub-Sections (5) & (6) of Section 25 could not be applied due to unreliable values. Market enquiry as envisaged under Sub-Section (7) of Section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969, was also conducted. Consequently, Section 25 (9) of the Customs Act 1969 was applied to determine the values of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS).
- Stakeholders' Participation in determination of Customs values: Meetings were held with stakeholders on 11-06-2014 and 28-06-2014.
- Customs values for Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS): Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) hereinafter specified shall be assessed to duty / taxes at the Customs values mentioned against them in Annex-A.
- 5. In cases where declared/ transaction values are higher than the Customs value determined in this Ruling, the assessing officer shall apply those values in terms of Sub-Section (1) of Section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969. In case of consignments imported by air, the assessing officer shall take into account the differential between air freight and sea freight while applying the Customs values determined in this Ruling.

Validity of this Valuation Ruling: The value determined vide this Ruling shall be the applicable Customs value for assessment of subject imported goods until and unless it is rescinded or revised by the competent authority in terms of Sub-Sections (1) or (3) of

Revision of the value determined vide this Valuation Ruling: A revision petition may be filed against this Ruling, as provided under Section 25-D of the Customs Act, 1969. within 30 days from the date of issue, before the Director General, Directorate General of Customs Valuation, 7th Floor, Custom House, Karachi.

The Collectors of Customs may kindly ensure that the values given in the Ruling for the given description of goods are applied by the concerned staff without fail. Any anomaly observed may kindly be brought to the notice of Directorate General immediately.
