Counsel for the petitioner says that on the basis of some information received from a website regarding price of imported goods, the respondents lodged an FIR against the petitioner alleging fiscal fraud in respect of duties and taxes in the tune of Rs.737,416/-. Counsel says that the website clearly makes a disclaimer that the information present on the website could not be used for any legal purposes, however, on the very basis the FIR and allegation of fraud has been built. Counsel further says that till this petition is taken up for final hearing, the petitioner is ready to secure the differential of all the duties and taxes as well as the fine and penalties, if any, against release of his consignment. Counsel for the respondent has no objection to such a proposition.

In the circumstances, let the goods of the petitioner be released on deposit of Rs.737,416/- with the Nazir of this Court by way of Pay Order/Bank Guarantee and fine and penalty with the Department through post-dated cheques.
