- All Deputy Collector / Assistant Collector, Incharge Group / Section of this Collectorate are hereby directed to ensure that appropriate replies to each correspondence received in the Group / Section are sent to the stakeholders, a proper register is maintained in the concerned Groups and Sections to keep track of all such correspondences and Principal Appraiser ensure that proper updations are made as per given time lines.
- Any lapse in this regard shall be viewed seriously and may result in initiation of disciplinary proceedings.
