GD would be marked to the same AO / EO by AC / DC Shed who had (d) earlier been detailed to supervise de-sealing / examination allowed under section 79(I) of the Custorns Act, 1969.

In case of absence of AO / EO to whom a GD is marked by "One (e) Customs", it will be marked to some other AO / EO by AC / DC Shed
