PUBLIC NOTICE NO. 26 (A)/2007

In continuation of Public Notice No. 48(A)/93 dated 08.09.1993 and with a view to streamline the marking of 'Goods Declarations' (GDs), processing on the day these are filed and to avoid procedural delays in examination of the goods, following amendments / additions are made in the said Public Notice:-

- (a) GDs will be marked for examination by "One Customs" without making any differentiation between AO / EO.
- (b) GD pertaining to MSA, if marked to AO/EO, will be marked to MSA by DC / AC Sheds.
- (c) GD pertaining to AO / EO, if marked to MSA, will be marked to AO / EO by AC / DC Sheds.
- (d) GD would be marked to the same AO / EO by AC / DC Shed who had earlier been detailed to supervise de-sealing / examination allowed under section 79(I) of the Customs Act, 1969.
- (e) In case of absence of AO / EO to whom a GD is marked by "One Customs", it will be marked to some other AO / EO by AC / DC Shed.
