**DETERMINATION OF CUSTOMS VALUES CIRCUIT BREAKERS / SWITCHES / SOCKETS UNDER SECTION 25-A OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969**

(VALUATION RULING NO.652 / 2014)

No.Misc/11/2013-VII

Dated : March 27, 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969, the Customs values for Circuit Breakers / Switches / Sockets are determined as follows:-

- Description of the valuation issue:** It was brought to the notice of Directorate General of Customs Valuation by various Collectorates that Circuit Breakers / Switches/ Sockets / were being imported at underinvoiced values. Therefore, an exercise to determine the customs values of the subject goods under Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969 was initiated.
- Method adopted to determine customs values:** Valuation methods provided in Section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969 were followed. Transaction value method provided in Sub-Section (1) of Section 25 was found inapplicable because requisite information required under the law was not available. Identical / similar goods value methods provided in Sub-Sections (5) & (6) of Section 25 ibid were examined but not found valid due to variable and unreliable values. Market enquiry was thus conducted under Sub-Section (7) of Section 25 and findings of enquiry as provided under Sub-Section (7) of Section 25 read with Sub-Section (9) ibid were adopted to determine the Customs values for Circuit Breakers/ Switches / Sockets.
- Stakeholders' participation in determination of customs values:** Meeting were convened with stakeholders on 06-05-2013, 22-11-2013 & 18-03-2014 wherein their views were sought regarding valuation of subject items.
- Customs Values of Circuit Breakers / Switches / Sockets :** Circuit Breakers/ Switches / Sockets *hereinafter specified*, shall be assessed to duty/taxes on the Customs values mentioned against them in the Table below : -

- In cases where declared / transaction values are higher than the Customs values determined in this Ruling, the assessing officers shall apply those values in terms of Sub-Section (1) of

Section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969. In case of consignments imported by air, the assessing officer shall take into account the differential between air freight and sea freight while applying the Customs values determined in this Ruling.

6. **Validity of Valuation Ruling:** The values determined vide this Ruling shall be the applicable Customs value for assessment of subject imported goods until and unless it is rescinded or revised by the competent authority in terms of Sub-Sections (1) or (3) of Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969.
7. **Review of the value determined vide this Valuation Ruling:** A review petition may be filed against this Ruling, as provided under Section 25-D of the Customs Act, 1969, within 30 days from the date of issue, before the Director General, Directorate General of Customs Valuation 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Custom House, Karachi.
8. The Collectors of Customs may kindly ensure that the values given in the Ruling for the given description of goods are applied by the concerned staff without fail. Any anomaly observed with respect to PCT may kindly be brought to the notice of Directorate General immediately.
