PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING AND CLEARANCE OF CONSIGNMENT

OF ALL SORTS OF SCRAP.

In order to further facilitate the trade and to reduce dwell time at port, Office Order No.04/2007 dated 04.12.2007 is amended and at the end of the first sentence of Para (iii) i.e. "the consignment of scrap shall be de-stuffed and examined 100% at a place specified for this purpose by the concerned custodian", following sentences are added with immediate effect:

"However, in case of following, 100% inspection but only upto 10% de-stuffing and examination shall be done:

Importer is an industrial concern.

Importer and clearing agent both enjoy clean history of 12 months with no case of any misdeclaration against them during this period. b)

Country of origin is other than UAE. c)

If discrepancy is found during examination of randomly selected containers, whole consignment will be de-stuffed and examined 100%".
