PROCEDURE FOR AUTOMATED PAYMENT OF DUTY & TAXES UNDER ONE-CUSTOMS PROJECT.

In order to bring the system of payment of duty and taxes within the automated regime of One-Customs, at Appraisement Collectorate, Custom House, Karachi, the following procedure has been devised to be followed by all concerned:-

- On completion of assessment of leviable duty and taxes in the Appraising Group, the (i) clearing agent or the importer, as the case may be, shall present the Goods Declaration (GD) alongwith pay-order / cash to the designated bank staff for payment. The bank staff after receipt of assessed amount of duty and taxes shall update the online computer system regarding payment and endorse the GD as well as the cash slip generated by the computer in the bank.
- On presentation of such G.D in the Accounts Section, the accounts staff shall verify the (ii) payment through online system, cross check it with the computer generated cash slip, duly endorsed by the bank, and allow G.D out of charge, after entering out of charge information in the computer system.
