SUBJECT: - <u>SIMPLIFICATION OF BILL OF EXPORT FOR EXPORTS TO</u> AFGHANISTAN AGAINST PAK RUPEES.

In order to facilitate exports to Afghanistan against Pak Rupees in which case no Customs Duty Drawback and zero-rating of Sales Tax and Central Excise duty is involved, the Central Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the exporters shall be required to provide the following information in the bills of export:-

- 1. Clearing agent's Name and Address.
- 2. Exporter's Name and Address:
- 3. Exporter's National Tax Number.
- 4. Exporter's Sales Tax Registration No.
- 5. Consignee's Name & Address.
- 6. Name of Customs Station.
- 7. Registration No. of vehicle.
- 8. Description of goods.
- 9. Weight/Quantity of goods.
- 10. Value of goods.
- 11. Export Development Surcharge.
- 2. Exporters will also not be required to attach supporting documents such as invoice and bill of lading etc. However, certificates prescribed by other departments and documents required under Export Policy and Procedure Order, 2000 will have to be submitted by the exporters.
