CUSTOMS GENERAL ORDER NO 9 OF 2004,

SUBJECT: -- DISCONTINUATION OF THE PRACTICE OF ISSUING PUBLIC NOTICES AND STANDING ORDERS.

It has been observed that Collectorates issue Public Notices and Standing Orders for facilitation, clarification, standardization of procedures etc. However, due to divergent practices and orders issued by the Collectorates on same issue, uniformity as envisaged under the Revised Kyoto Convention is not being attained at all the customs stations. Therefore, it has been decided that Collectorates will not issue Public Notices and Standing Orders, in future. However, if a need arises, a draft Public Notice or Standing Order will be sent to the Central Board of Revenue for further necessary action.
