**NOTIFICATION
(CUSTOMS, SALES TAX)**

S.R.O. 767(I)/2014.-In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3BB and 3E of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and sections 30 and 31 of Sales Tax Act, 1990, the Federal Board of Revenue is pleased to notify the formation of the Directorate General of Reforms and Automation, Islamabad, Directorates of Reforms and Automations, Karachi, Lahore and Islamabad and appoint, namely:-

- (a) the officer specified in column (2) of the Table below to be the Director General of the Reforms and Automation, Islamabad for the areas of territorial jurisdiction specified in corresponding column (3) thereof;
- (b) the officer specified in column (2) of the table below to be the Directors of the Reforms and Automation, Karachi, Lahore and Islamabad for the areas of territorial jurisdiction specified in corresponding column (3), thereof; and
- (c) the Additional Directors, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors, Principal Appraisers, Appraiser, Deputy Superintendents, to be the respective officers of Customs of those areas, namely:--

2. The area of functional jurisdiction of the officers designated in column (2) of the Table shall be as follows:--

- (i) development of new systems in the light of International Best Practices and inputs from relevant quarters and on their recommendations of FBR preparation of user manuals including training modules for customs computerized systems;

- (ii) amendment, improvement, modification or re-engineering of the existing system on the recommendations or approval of FBR;
- (iii) facilitate IPR protection of all indigenously developed customs computerized systems.
- (iv) development of performance benchmarks of customs business processes. Recommendation to FBR for hiring of consultants, on need basis, in respect of new automation or reform initiatives;
- (v) facilitate development of Requirement specifications for Electronic data Interchange at the operational level;
- (vi) facilitate the design and development of website(s) for field and support formations of Customs department, whenever required;
- (vii) identify the need for procurement, installation and maintenance of hardware, software and networking equipment for Customs department;
- (viii) facilitate the provision of technical support to the field and support formations for addressing system related malfunctioning; and
- (ix) any other function assigned by the Federal Board of Revenue or by the Member (Customs).
