

Subject: VALUATION ADVICE IN RESPECT OF AFGHAN ORIGIN GOODS

There has been a consistent demand from the traders who import goods from Afghanistan via land route that Valuation Rulings issued under Section 25-A of the Customs Act, 1969 should address the differences between sea/ air-freight and land-freight. Moreover, they argued that goods imported from Afghanistan are mostly seasonal in nature and their values fluctuate during peak and off-peak seasons.

2. Therefore, it has been decided, in consultation with MCC (Appraisement and Facilitation) Quetta and Peshawar, stakeholders and representative Associations to fix values of Afghanistan origin goods imported via land route for a period of three months and a mechanism may be devised to continuously update the values in view of their seasonal nature. Accordingly, MCC (Appraisement and Facilitation) Quetta and Peshawar conducted market surveys and communicated a list of items imported from Afghanistan along with their proposed customs values. In the light of these surveys, a valuation advice is being issued for minimum Customs values as mentioned in Column (4) of the enclosed Annexure for the purpose of assessment of duty and taxes for Afghan origin goods only.

3. The valuation Advice is valid for a period of three months from its date of issuance. In case Collectorate(s) observe any change in the values of the imported goods and consider it necessary to amend this valuation advice, they may send their proposal immediately to this Directorate General along with justification for further necessary action.
