Pakistan Customs Laws

- Any stores or equipment when sold abroad on Government to Government basis and exported under an export licence issued by the Director of Pakistan (Army) or by any other officer authorised by the Ministry of Defence.
- Bona fide samples provided that -
 - (a) the FOB value of such samples does not exceed the limit prescribed by the Ministry of Commerce; and (b)
 - the samples are supplied free of charge.
- 8. Gift parcels of value not exceeding one thousand rupees each. 9.
- Goods exported to and from the Export Processing Zone. 10.
- Relief goods sent as aid for those affected by natural disaster or catastrophe. 11.
- Goods sent abroad for trade fairs, repair and renovation or calibration.
- 12. Wheat being supplied to Afghanistan on Government to Government basis.
